The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine invites applications for Director of Gynecologic Pathology at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. The successful candidate will join a subspecialized anatomic pathology service which supports the clinical and academic missions of an internationally recognized department. Strength of diagnostic expertise and/or fellowship training and academic accomplishment in gynecologic pathology are essential. Professional appointment and salary level will be commensurate with experience.

Cedars-Sinai Medical Center, located at the junction of Los Angeles and Beverly Hills, is an 886 licensed bed quaternary medical care facility and is the largest private not-for-profit provider of health care on the West Coast, serving more than 9 million people in Los Angeles County, treating more cancer patients than any other medical center in Southern California. Cedars-Sinai has an active obstetrics and gynecology residency and has one of the few gynecologic oncology fellowship training programs in the nation. There are five gynecologic oncologists who generate ~1500 cases per year. The Gynecologic Oncology Division has an active research program in women's cancer biology and collaborative research efforts are ongoing including participation in The Cancer Genome Atlas Program. The Director will be employed by Beverly Pathology, an independently contracted pathology group under the Cedars-Sinai Medical Foundation providing exclusive pathology services to the Medical Center.

The 50 faculty members of the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine direct a clinical operation of over approximately 5 million laboratory tests, robust outreach and consultative referral practices. The Division of Anatomic Pathology provides comprehensive diagnostic service for nearly 80,000 surgical and 25,000 cytology cases annually, including more than 6,000 gynecologic pathology cases. All faculty participate in teaching residents, fellows and students and engage in scholarship, including basic, translational and/or clinical research. Candidates who are also laboratory scientists will be provided high quality laboratory space and excellent start-up support.

Eligibility for an academic appointment in the Cedars-Sinai Health System Professorial Program is required.
