- Hold a current junior LASOP membership (free for residents/fellows)

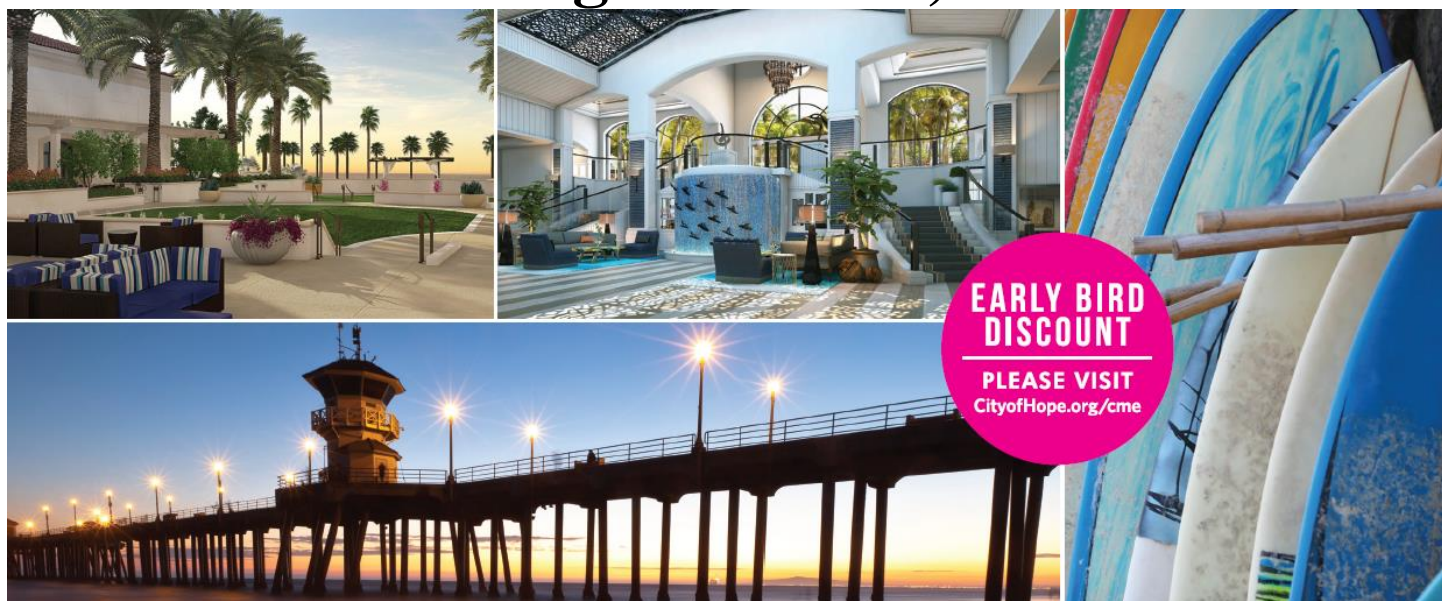
Submit for consideration of the Executive Board:

Directions to Moseley Salvatori Conference Center: (Adjacent to Good Samaritan Hospital)
